The Redwood Area Chamber Ag Committee is pleased to announce the scholarship recipients for the 2022-23 school year.

One of the goals of the Redwood Area Chamber Ag Committee's Scholarship Program is to promote and strengthen area agriculture by supporting college-bound students from rural communities as they pursue their academic goals. With this support, we hope to develop future leaders for agriculture companies and our rural communities.

The Redwood Area Chamber Ag Committee is a committee of Redwood Area Chamber & Tourism and works to advocate and educate for agriculture in our area. One of their Scholarship Programs, through a partnership with Agriculture Future of America, funds scholarships for high school graduates, who live or go to school in Redwood County, that are pursuing post-secondary 4-year degrees in agriculture and related degree programs. Another scholarship program funds scholarships for high school graduates, who live or go to school in Redwood County, that are pursuing post-secondary 2-year degrees in agriculture and related degree programs.

Proceeds from two area golf tournaments fund the Scholarship Program. The Ribeye Open is scheduled for July 10, 2023, at the Redwood Falls Golf Club in Redwood Falls, and the Pork Chop Open is scheduled for July 27, 2023, at the Farmers Golf & Health Club in Sanborn. 
